14 letters and emails had been received into the office siting the cases against closing the pool in the winter months. 2 emails wrote to agree with the closure. A number of the same parents also contacted members of the Parent forum directly. Miss Stock had also been given details of an online petition (at the time of the meeting there were 137 signatures) but having checked the signature - a significant number of these signatures do not pay for the swimming SO this was discounted.

From the emails and letters Parents expressed they were willing to pay extra but were either unhappy at the closure for it lacked continuity for the swimming lessons or that they would rather not let their children swim in winter blaming colds and generally being unwell with wet hair.

Alternative PE was discussed if the swimming lessons were to stop during the Winter period.

Water Safety Courses, visits from the RNLI and paramedics were all ideas to keep the water issue to the forefront due to parents concerns about children drowning.

The pool funding is already in a deficit and even if the outstanding monies were paid there would still be a struggle for the next 5 years given the 8% funding cut nationwide from the Government.

Alternative ideas were discussed to raise funds and cuts to be made to staffing, rewards scheme dropped and trips affected. None of these would save the money needed.

The issue of publishing a list of non-paying parents, as do other schools, was also discussed.
