Pupil Achievements

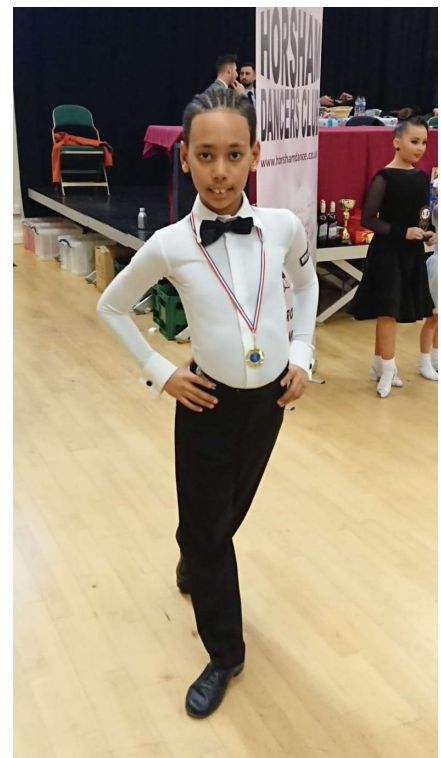
