We miss you already!

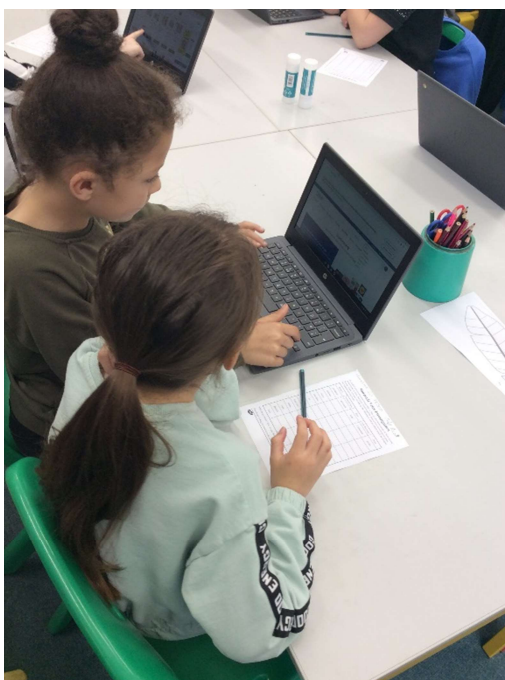
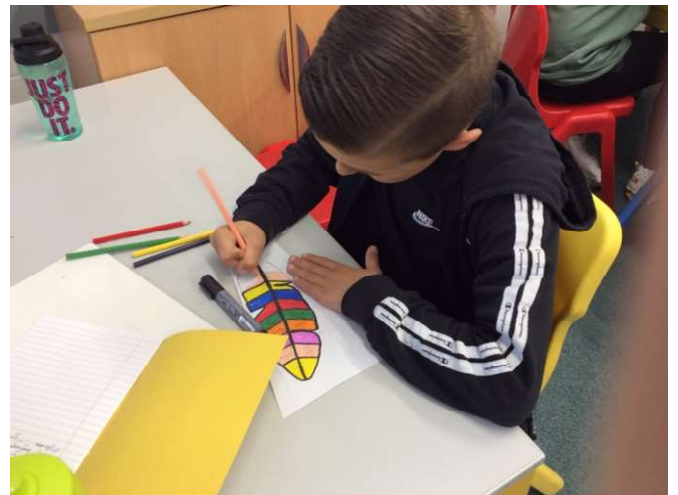
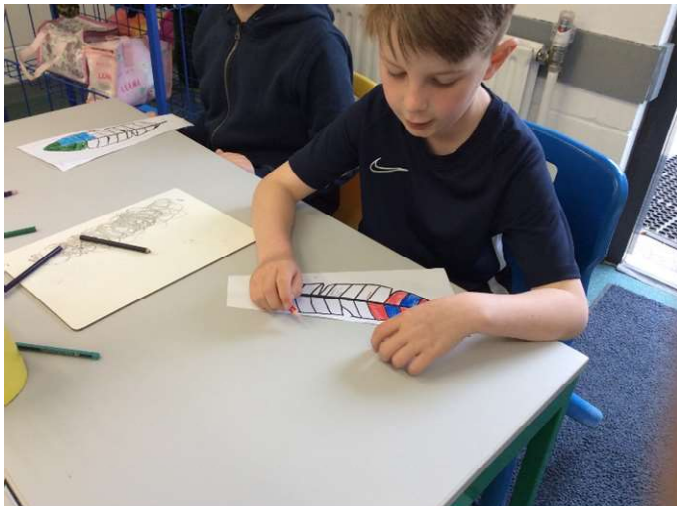

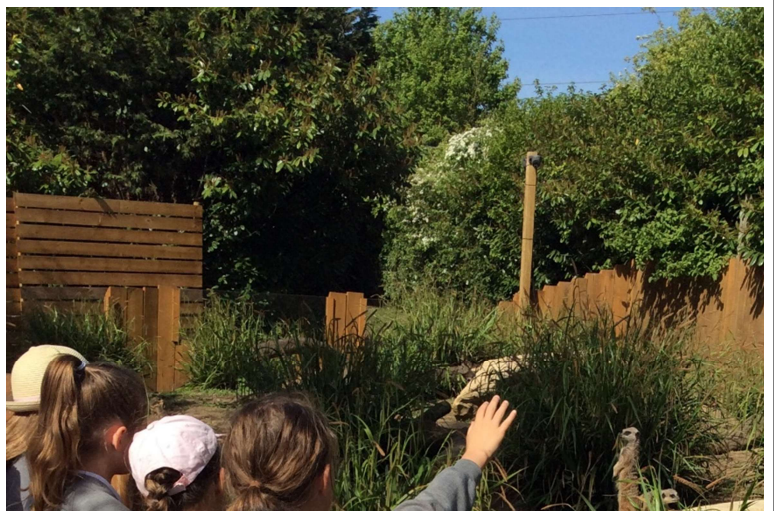
Year 5
