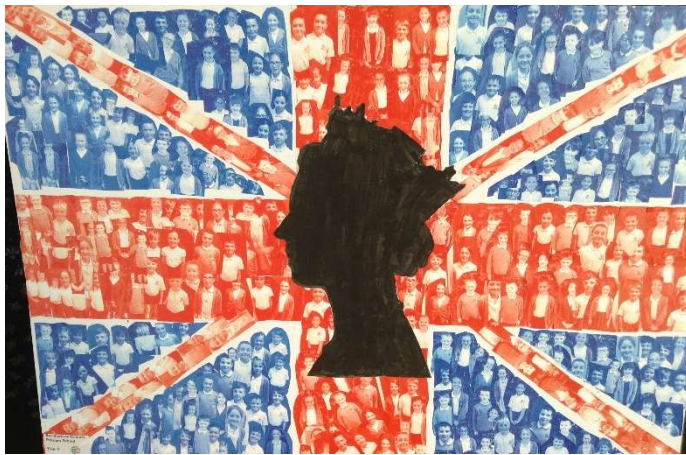




## Art trail
