
Remembrance Parade

Reception admissions for academic year starting in September 2023

As you may be aware, the primary school (Reception) admission round opened on **Monday 7 November 2022**, for parents of children to apply for a Reception school place for the academic year that starts in September 2023.

The statutory national closing date for applications is **15 January 2023**.

From 7 November 2022, applications can be made online via <u>www.essex.gov.uk/admissions</u>. 99% of parents in Essex applied online last year.

All of the application information is available on the website above.

The website also has a copy of the Primary Education in Essex 2023-24 booklet and the Schools Admissions Policies Directories contain details of all admission policies.

Please remember you need to apply by the deadline of **15 January 2023**. Even if you already have a child at the school, you will still need to apply if you have a child due to start Reception next September.
