World Book day

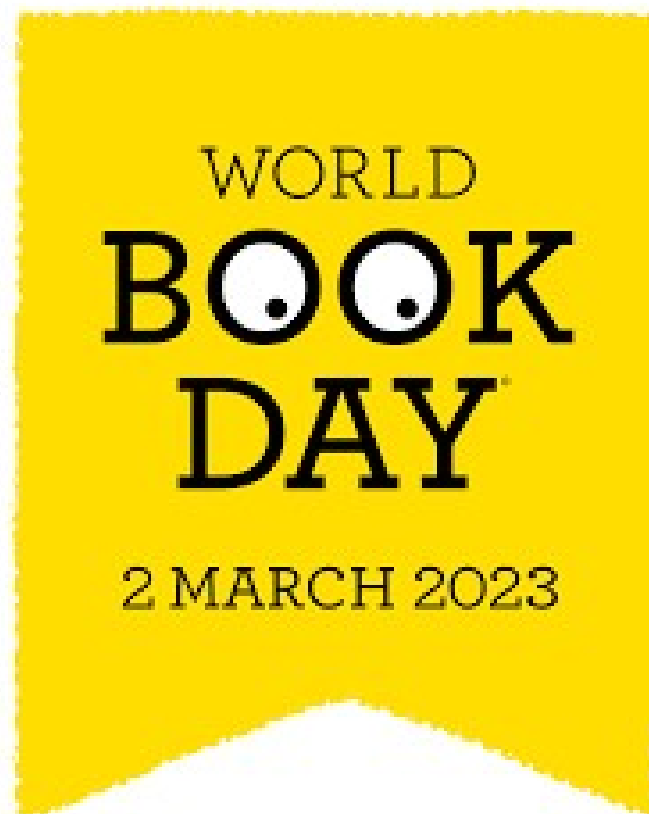
Dear Parents / Carers,

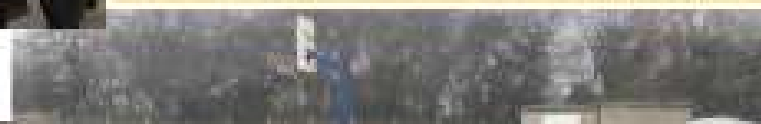

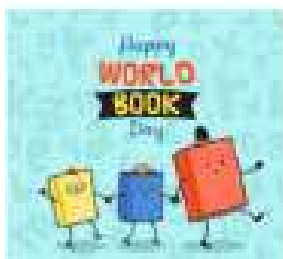
