




























Worry Monsters

The children of BCPS would like to say 'A BIG THANK YOU' to the PTA for funding a worry monster for every classroom.

We all have worries, both children and adults. They are a necessary and normal part of life. Sometimes, when worries get out of hand or are irrational, they can stop us achieving our goals, dreams and living our life to the full. A worry monster is a <u>soft toy that is designed to help children manage their worries</u> and anxieties. The idea is that children can either write down their worries or fears on a piece of paper or use their imagination and then feed them to the worry monster, which will "eat" the worry and take it away.









Child Safety at Easter

Mini Eggs can pose a serious choking hazard to young children, as they are just the right size to block a child's airway, meaning they can be incredibly hard to dislodge if it becomes stuck. Unlike grapes which are a similar size and shape, mini eggs are not easy to cut into smaller pieces.

The Child Accident Prevention Trust (CAPT) have advised that parents may want to crush the mini eggs with a pestle and mortar or rolling pin. Alternatively, they said parents may want to opt for a different treat altogether as larger, hollow Easter eggs are much safer.


